



## City of Yorba Linda Dog Play Lot Rules

This neighborhood Dog Fun Zone was created to allow both people with dogs and other park users to safely use the play lot.

This park can be used by a sole owner or with other owners whose dogs get along well with each other.

We ask that you help us make the dog play lots fun for everyone by using common sense, reporting trouble makers, and policing yourselves. You are entering an off-leash dog play area and you enter at your own risk.

1. Please pick up after your dog.
2. Abandoning a dog or leaving it unattended is against the law.
3. Please keep the gate closed at all time to keep the dogs contained.
4. Dog play lots are for people with their dogs, no other use is allowed. Dog owners/guardians must accept full responsibility for themselves, their children/guests, and their dogs(s) while in the dog play lot. (Cal. Civil Code 3342(A)). The City is not liable for any injury or harm caused by any person or dog entering or remaining in the dog play lot. Dog owners/guardians are responsible to fully indemnify the City on all claim arising out of injury or harm caused by their dog or by their individual actions.
5. Dogs that are aggressive, have vicious tendencies, are sick, or in heat are not permitted in the dog play lot. It is the responsibility of the owner/guardian to ensure that all dogs entering the dog play lot are licensed and current on vaccinations.
6. Please respect your neighbors, be courteous and share time of use if the dog play lot is crowded.
7. No events are allowed and this is not a dog training facility for trainers.
